

Son Servants Work Crew Application 2025

What is Work Crew?

Son Servants Work Crew is a unique opportunity for those who share a love of youth ministry with a heart for missions. As part of a dynamic community of believers, the Work Crew's primary function is to serve others, but in doing so they often find their own relationship with Christ has deepened.

Eligibility Requirements

- One year post high school for all High School and Middle school trips. However rising seniors may apply for Middle School only trips.
- Demonstrate a commitment to Christ and a desire to serve Him through youth mission experiences.
- Availability: this may range from the first week of June through the last week of July, or on a week-by-week basis, based on your availability.

Orientation

• Virtual orientation before the summer begins (day and time TBD). This will help clarify and answer questions and expectations for the week(s) and allow time to meet each other. There will be one orientation for June trips and one orientation for July trips.

Time Commitment

- You are expected to arrive the day prior to the start of the trip (for example, if the trip starts on Monday, July 21, we need you to arrive Sunday, July 20).
- You will serve for the entire week and leave the date the trip ends.
- You may serve more than one week of the summer. Please designate below the week(s) you are available to serve:
 - If you can serve more than one week, we will work with you regarding arrivals/departures and time planning

Work Commitment/ What to expect

- The primary responsibility of Work Crew is to serve the youth and adults on the Son Servants trips. You will be working hard all week doing a variety of things.
 - Lead work teams on trip work projects (home repair, VBS, painting, etc.)
 - Share your faith story in large or small settings

- Pack lunch and water coolers
- o Wash dishes and/or direct students in washing their own dishes
- Lead games during evening program
- \circ $\;$ Help with camp set-up and camp tear down and closing
- o And a plethora of other behind-the-scenes tasks which make these trips possible

The tasks Work Crew are involved in are bound to stretch you, both physically and spiritually. No matter where you are or what you're doing. We hope the Work Crew will have the attitudes of servants – keeping your eyes open for anything you can do to make the Son Servants camp a great experience for everyone!

Spiritual Commitment

- If you are a rising senior in high school, you are likely arriving with your church group to help serve. We expect you to serve as part of Work Crew and join your church group for family time at the end of the day. We want you to continue to grow in your faith, be a leader within your family time, and serve the students of your home church by being a faith example.
- If you are post-high school / college-aged, we would like to invite you to the Staff family time, where we set aside for exploring our faiths, together, and discussing what we are learning throughout the week and summer. We will share a devotional, have discussion time, and take time to pray with and for each other. These mission trips provide amazing and sweet opportunities for Work Crew to experience true Christian community.

Financial Commitment

- Due to the nature of our summer schedule, you may only be able to serve for one week, or for three weeks in a row. Our expectation is that you get yourself to and from the location of the trip and we will take care of the rest (housing, meals, etc.). This is a volunteer position.
 - If you are able to serve on multiple trips that are back-to-back, we will work with you on accommodations for the weekend dates between trips
 - If you are able to serve multiple trips that are NOT back-to-back, you will be responsible for getting to/from the trip
 - If you are wary of arriving to an unknown location, we will work with you! We do not want transportation to be the reason you are limited to serve

Application Deadline

The application deadline for Work Crew is February 28, 2025, though we do recommend you get your application in as soon as possible. As soon as we receive your application or as soon as the deadline passes, we will contact you and schedule a phone interview. Final staff selections will be made no later than March 25, and all applicants will be notified of their status at that time. If offered a position, you would be asked to let us know if you accept the position within a week.

Dress Code

Dress code for staff is the same as for students and leaders, functionally modest. You can find that info online in our leader handbook. Which you should become familiar with.

Social Media/Technology

Social media and technology are wonderful tools, but that can be distracting, Especially when you have safety responsibility. Our staff is asked to refrain from using social media during any and all camp activities. Using your phone for an alarm clock and taking pictures is allowed and encouraged.
